

Top Shelf Pipe Rack with Wheels



List of Parts



- Two people are helpful when assembling Top Shelf Pipe Rack.
- Required tools: phillips head screw driver or drill.
- Helpful Tools: pipe wrench.

Assembly

1. Lay pipe (A) on floor.
2. Screw (B) pipes into each side of pipe (A).
3. Undo union fitting in the middle of pipe (C). Screw each piece of pipe (C) into tee fittings on bottom of (B) pipes and tighten. Rotate both pieces of pipe (C) clockwise until union fitting is in line. This will tighten (B) pipes. Screw union fitting back together.
4. Screw base (D) onto (B) pipes. Make sure base is tight and perpendicular to the rack.
5. Flip rack right side up. Place wood shelf (E) on top of rack with the pre drilled holes facing down. Align pre drilled holes with holes on flange fittings. You may need to rotate flange fittings on pipe (A) for holes to align. Attach shelf with provided screws using phillips head screw driver or drill.

Enjoy!



- If needed, level rack by tightening or loosening caster wheels on bottom of base (D).
- Periodically wipe rack using cloth/rag or clean with mild degreaser (i.e. Simple Green). NEVER use water to clean rack.
